

How to Order a Custom dress design

Creating a custom dress design is a process. Whether you plan to compete or not, it is important to understand how to choose that Perfect Dress that will help you look your best.

Contact me at least 1 month in advance and indicate the time when the dress is needed.

However, we do rush orders considering the style of the dress, but with an extra charge.

Our pricing is based on custom order specifics: design of the dress, size of the dress, fabrics, embellishments, accessories and stone gross. The price for accessories is separate. We must agree on the style of the dress, color, fabrics, trims, embellishments and cost. I will work with you to accomplish your aspiration, meet your budget, and your desired look.

To design a perfect costume, I must totally understand you and your desires. There are so many essentials that should be taken into consideration. Therefore, I would like for you to give me as much information about yourself as possible. The questions below will help me while I am creating your design.

- 1. Your measurements. Make sure that someone else will take your measurements for accuracy. It is recommended that a local professional tailor take your measurements, as we do not accept returns for custom-made dresses.
- 2. Your height.
- 3. Several photos of you taken in full length, front, back and side.
- 4. Describe your body type. What parts of the body would you like to emphasize and what parts to cover.
- 5. Your general likes and dislikes of dress styles. Photos or sketches of dresses you like to help in creating your original.
- 6. Would you like the dress design to accentuate your dancing moves? For example (a skirt that gives you a lot of movement.)
- 7. I always like to hear music used in your dance and video of the choreography. If the video is not available, then just describe the general theme of the dance. This question mostly applies to costumes for artistic gymnastic, ice skaters, ice dancers, and ballroom dancers looking for a dress for a particular showcase.
- 8. Your favorite colors; colors that flatter your skin tone.

9. Indicate costuming restrictions which may apply to your dance level. 10. Your age.

11. The designing Process:

Once the cost of the dress is agreed upon and I receive the 50% Non-refundable deposit, I will begin the designing process. This includes any preliminaries. When you approve the sketches, then I will purchase materials specifically for your dress design.

While making your dress I will keep you posted via e-mails or phone calls. I will send you the pictures of the finished dress for your approval before shipment.
